

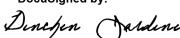

CAMC Institution and/or Program Closure or Reduction Policy

In the event of a sponsoring institution hospital closure, loss of institution accreditation, or decision to reduce or discontinue a training program, CAMC administration will make a good faith effort to inform affected residents and fellows in a timely manner and implement the following action steps:

- Make reasonable efforts to allow currently enrolled residents and fellows to complete their education. Should they be unable to complete their education within the sponsoring institution, CAMC will make its best effort to assist residents and fellows in securing an appropriate position in an accredited program of the same specialty at a comparable PGL level.
- Consider the temporary or permanent transfer of GME cap as may be allowed under CMS or regulatory requirements.
- Exercise proper care, custody, and disposition of resident and fellow education and training records and work expeditiously with respective accreditation bodies, regulatory agencies, licensing boards, and other entities, as necessary.
- Comply with all other applicable laws and regulations required of an institution should the closure or reduction be deemed a “plant closing” or “mass layoff”.
